WHAT SETS STM APART

- 1. Community:** Supportive families are the heart of STM — organizing events, volunteering, and showing up for one another. From Parish picnics to classroom celebrations, our families create lasting friendships and lifelong connections. At STM, community isn't just something we talk about — it's something we live every day. We are family.
- 2. Faith & Parish Connection**
Rooted in Gospel values and Catholic tradition, STM works in close partnership with St. Thomas More Catholic Church to nurture each child's faith and sense of purpose. Students live what they learn—growing in character and confidence through service, prayer, and acts of compassion.
- 3. Rigorous Academics:** A dynamic and engaging curriculum that challenges students to think critically, ask questions, and discover their gifts. STM teachers inspire curiosity, creativity, and a lifelong love of learning.
- 4. Small Class Sizes:** With an 11:1 student-to-teacher ratio, STM ensures that every child is seen, heard, and supported. Not all great minds think alike — and we celebrate that.
- 5. Personalized Learning & Early Literacy Support:** At STM, every child's learning journey is unique — and supported every step of the way. Our **Learning Resource Program** and comprehensive literacy instruction help students reach their full potential. All kindergarteners and new students receive benchmark assessments and individualized support as needed — ensuring every learner has what they need to succeed. From day one, STM nurtures a love of reading through a science-based approach that builds strong skills, confidence, and a lifelong joy for learning.
- 6. Enrichment & Experiential Learning:** Learning at STM extends far beyond the classroom. From STEAM Club and drama to outdoor adventures, Washington, D.C. trips, and service projects, students explore their passions and live their faith through hands-on experiences that inspire curiosity and growth. Middle school enrichment classes—such as coding, photography, ceramics, crafts for a cause, weight lifting, and math—give students opportunities to discover new skills, build confidence, and connect learning with real-world experiences.
- 7. Technology & Innovation:** Every student (K-8) receives a personal Apple iPad, encouraging creativity, critical thinking, and collaboration. Supported by a full-time tech specialist, STM helps students become confident, responsible digital citizens ready to thrive in an AI-driven world. As a cell phone-free campus, STM fosters focus, real connection, and authentic learning in every classroom.
- 8. Project HOPE:** Faith in action comes to life through Project HOPE, where STM students engage in hands-on volunteer experiences with teacher-selected local nonprofits and community organizations—building compassion, empathy, and a lifelong commitment to service.
- 9. Enriched Curriculum:** Beyond core academics, students flourish through specialist-taught classes in Art, Music, PE, Spanish, Technology, and Library. STM also offers accredited after-school care and a nutritious hot lunch program served five days a week, prepared fresh in our on-site commercial kitchen.

MORECARE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM

At St. Thomas More Catholic School, care doesn't end when the bell rings. Our MoreCare Program provides a safe, respectful, and loving environment for STM students ages 4–12 from dismissal until 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

What Families Love About MoreCare

- Licensed & Trusted: Nonprofit program licensed by the Oregon Child Care Division, led by Principal Katy Smith and Director Ms. Louise Carruth.
- Convenient: Students go directly from their classrooms to the Parish Hall; Pre-K and Kindergarteners are escorted.
- Balanced Routine: Snack, prayer, homework help, and supervised playtime—indoors and outdoors.
- Engaging Activities: Board games, crafts, Legos, books, dramatic play, and more.
- Positive Environment: Rooted in STM's philosophy of respect and encouragement, students earn "stars" for responsibility and kindness, redeemable in the MoreCare Store.

Program Details

- Location: STM Parish Hall & Playground
- Schedule: Open on school days only (closed on holidays, vacations, and noon dismissals)
- Monthly Sign-Ups: Available on STM's website the 1st – 25th of each month for the following month.
- Fees: \$50 per-family registration + \$15 per child, per day. Billed monthly through FACTS.
- Late Pick-Up: \$10 after 5:35 p.m.; \$1 per minute after 5:45 p.m.
- Snacks: Nut-free program—please pack two healthy snacks and a water bottle; fresh fruit and cheese also provided.
- Health & Safety: Follows STM and state health guidelines. All staff are first-aid trained.



At St. Thomas More Catholic School, tuition reflects the true cost of delivering a high-quality, faith-centered education while remaining competitive with other Portland-area schools. Our approach prioritizes strong academics, exceptional educators, and a supportive, values-driven community.

Tuition Rates

- In-Parish Tuition: \$11,150
- Out-of-Parish Tuition: \$13,650

In-Parish Tuition Benefit | Active Parishioner Scholarship

STM offers a reduced tuition rate for active parishioners.

To qualify, families must:

- Be registered members of St. Thomas More Catholic Church
- Attend weekend Mass regularly
- Provide verifiable parish support (\$1,040 annually / \$20 weekly)
- Participate in at least one parish ministry

Family Volunteer Commitment

Each family completes 20 volunteer units per school year in areas such as classrooms, events, athletics, Project HOPE, or parish activities.

- Volunteer hours are tracked through FACTS
- Unfulfilled units are billed at \$50 per unit (up to \$1,000)
- Credit is given for CYO coaches and field-trip chaperones

Fundraising at STM

Fundraising is voluntary, not mandatory. Contributions support:

- Experiential learning and enrichment
- Classroom and campus enhancements
- Tuition assistance

The annual STM Auction remains a cornerstone community event.
